

### **Professor Bruce Hansen, University of Wisconsin (Econometrics)**

Bruce E. Hansen was a student of Peter Phillips at Yale University, receiving his Ph.D. in 1989. He is currently the Tryge Haavelmo Professor of Economics at the University of Wisconsin, and previously held positions at the University of Rochester (1989-1994) and Boston College (1994-1998). He was Co-Editor of *Econometric Theory* during 1995-2008 and Associate Editor of *Econometrica* for the period 1996-2008. He is a Fellow of the Econometric Society and of the *Journal of Econometrics*. He works in econometric methods, with main interests in econometric theory, time series, nonlinear modelling, nonparametrics, model selection and averaging, and shrinkage estimation.
