

**Professor Joseph Hotz, Duke University (Labour Economics and Public Policy)**

“V. Joseph Hotz is the Arts and Sciences Professor of Economics at Duke University. He specializes in the areas of labor economics, economics of the family, applied econometrics, and evaluating the impact of social programs. His current research focuses on game-theoretic models of the interactions and resource allocation decisions of extended families; the economics of child care markets; the effects of alternative public policies on higher education markets in the U.S.; and identification and statistical inference of regression models with missing covariate data. Hotz is a Fellow of the Econometric Society.”
