



Professor Peter A Petri, Brandeis University (International Trade and Finance)

Peter A. Petri is the Carl J. Shapiro Professor of International Finance at the Brandeis International Business School (IBS) and Senior Fellow of the East-West Center in Honolulu, Hawaii. His research focuses on international trade, finance and investment, primarily in the Asia Pacific. He was founding Dean of IBS from 1994 to 2006, has held visiting appointments at the Asian Development Bank Institute, the Brookings Institution, Fudan University, Keio University, Peking University, the OECD and the World Bank, and consults for numerous international organizations and governments. He serves on the editorial boards of journals dedicated to Asia-Pacific research and is the Convener of the *East-West Dialogue*. He is a member of the U.S. Asia Pacific Council, the PAFTAD International Steering Committee, and a former Chair of the U.S. APEC Study Center Consortium. He received A.B. and Ph.D. degrees in economics from Harvard University.
